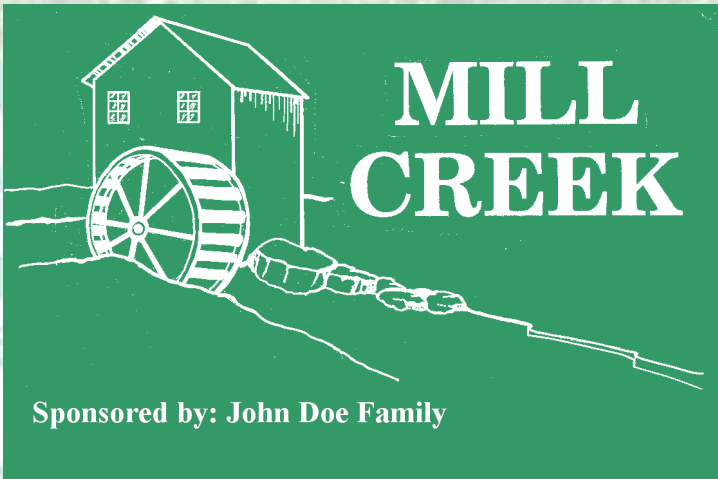

Sponsorship—Sign Our Streams

- ◆ **Medina County Soil & Water Conservation District (SWCD) will maintain a map of eligible named stream crossings (those sponsored and those available).**
- ◆ **Any party interested in sponsoring a crossing should come to the SWCD office to fill out the Sponsorship Request Form.**
- ◆ **Sponsorship fee of \$150 must be paid in full prior to the sign order being placed.**
- ◆ **SWCD will assume responsibility for delivering signs to respective jurisdictions.**
- ◆ **Once the two (2) signs are erected, the SWCD responsibility ends.**
- ◆ **Signs may need to be replaced due to damage, theft, defacing, vandalism, etc. The original sponsor of the crossing may choose to re-sponsor the crossing or if not, the crossing will be made available for sponsorship to the general public.**
