Garlic mustard (*Alliaria petiolata*) is an invasive species growing in the forests of Ohio and many other states. It can be harmful to these environments, and plant ecosystems; therefore pulling garlic mustard is critical. After pulling it, some people turn its leaves into a pesto. Whether you're eating or pitching it, always securely bag it and dispose of all unused parts.
