7 Steps to take a soil sample

- You will need a separate soil sample for each individual area. (garden, flowerbed, lawn, or pasture)
- 2. Randomly collect five to six samples from the area.
- 3. Place samples into a clean plastic container for air drying.
- 4. Remove stones and root clumps (roots and plants).
- 5. Mix the five to six samples together.
- 6. Remove about two cups of soil and place into a zip lock bag.
- 7. Sample is ready to be brought to the Medina SWCD Office.

There is an \$20.00 charge that will cover the cost of the soil test and shipping.

Test results can be emailed or mailed, once received, recommendations can be interpreted.
