1	<b>Blue False Indigo</b> <i>Baptisia australis</i>	3 - 4ft	May - July	Full - Partial	Drought tolerant once established, supports queen bumblebees
2	<b>Dense Blazingstar</b> <i>Liatris spicata</i>	2-5ft	July-Sept	Full Sun	Prefers moist soils, decorative
3	<b>Hoary Skullcap</b> <i>Scutellaria incana</i>	2-3ft	June - Sept	Partial Sun	Tolerates clay soil, drought tolerant, good for home landscaping
4	<b>Obedient Plant</b> <i>Physostegia virginiana</i>	2-4ft	July-Sept	Full - Partial	Moist soils, deer resistant, great for bumblebees
5	<b>Ohio Spiderwort</b> <i>Tradescantia ohioensis</i>	2-4ft	May-July	Full - Partial	Long bloom period, prefers soil moisture, good for home landscaping
6	<b>Prairie Dock</b> <i>Silphium terebinthinaceum</i>	Leaves 2ft, Flowers 10ft	July - Sept	Full Sun	Good drought tolerance, great for pollinators
7	<b>Red Lobelia</b> <i>Lobelia cardinalis</i>	2-3ft	July - Sept	Full - Partial	Prefers consistently moist soils, attracts hummingbirds
8	<b>Short-toothed Mtn Mint</b> <i>Pycnanthemum muticum</i>	3ft	July - Sept	Full - Partial	Aromatic, pollinator magnet
9	<b>Showy Coneflower</b> <i>Rudibeckia fulgida var. speciosa</i>	1-2ft	July - Sept	Full - Partial	Great for home landscaping
10	<b>Smooth Blue Aster</b> <i>Symphyotrichum leave</i>	1-3ft	Aug - Oct	Full - Partial	Tolerates clay soil, great for pollinators
11	<b>Smooth Penstemon</b> <i>Penstemon digitalis</i>	3-4ft	June - July	Full - Partial	Great for home landscaping
12	<b>Spotted Joe Pye</b> <i>Eutrochium maculatum</i>	3-5ft	July - Sept	Full - Partial sun	Pollinator magnet, prefers moist soils
13	<b>Stiff Goldenrod</b> <i>Oligoneuron rigidum</i>	2-5ft	Aug - Oct	Full Sun	Pollinator host plant, tolerates clay soil, very attractive plant
14	<b>Wingstem</b> <i>Verbesina alternifolia</i>	3-8ft	July - Oct	Full Sun - Partial	Great for privacy fence, needs moist soils, supports native bees
